And call me a cock-eyed optimist, but it feels like it's making a difference. We've moved the needle on most of these issues in Colorado, and there are promising signs that as Colorado goes, so, eventually, may go the nation.

Here's one interesting tell: my YouTube channel just went over 100,000 hits. I've got over 600 videos up, and the vast majority of them are political, though there's a fair amount of music also. I'd wager the lion's share of the videos are of Senator Irene Aguilar, and her press conference announcing her Colorado Health Care Cooperative remains one of the more popular videos.

Last week the reigning champion at the top of my hit list was a video of President Obama arriving in Aurora on Air Force One last summer, a perennial #1 ever since I posted it. Slots 3-9 are filled with Telluride Bluegrass Festivals ranging from Sam Bush, Bela Fleck, and Chris Thile to Jackson Browne, Steve Martin, and Edie Brickell. But the #2 video for the week was Chuck Kutscher's Climate Change presentation in Golden last week. If you missed the symposium, click the link for wonderful videos from Golden.

Hooray for science! And I hope you can join us next week for a follow-up in Denver on the DU Law Campus with a special focus on the Colorado common ground of Wildfire, Drought, and Environmental Health.

I'm going to keep this *relatively* short, since there's still much to do this month, and as much as I love to talk and write, I love action even more. When I stepped up my involvement in the Democratic Party years ago and was elected Denver County Secretary, one of my biggest goals was to turn our idealism into action.
